POSITION PAPER

The official position is the document made by the delegates that expresses the point of view, the position and the possible solutions of the country that is representing about the topics that will be discussed in the agenda.

REQUIREMENTS

- A) Consider the correct use of grammar and spelling.
- B) Use appropriate and diplomatic vocabulary.
- C) Avoid using any of the following words that should be exchanged for a more appropriate synonym or term:
 - **"Kill", "Assassinate", "Murdered"** related, use the term: "take the life of"
 - **"Okay"** for the implicit word to kill, use the term "It's OK" or related.
 - **"War"** can only be approved as a historical event (World War I, World War II, Cold War) if not; use the term "armed conflict."
 - **"Bombs"** use the term: "explosive devices"
 - **"Guns"** use the terms: "weapons"
 - **"God"** is not allowed as an argument
 - **"Black", "White"** and related. It is considered racist and will not be used.
 - **"Poor", "Rich"** talking about people or countries; use the term "With (without) resources"
 - **"First / second / third world"** use the term: "Developed / developing country"
 - **"P5"** use the term "G5" as a reference of the Security Council of the 5 permanent members
 - **"Rape"** use the term "sexual abuse"
- D) The length of the document should not exceed 1 page per topic.
- E) The text must be written with the **Arial** font type. It's size must be 12.
- F) The text must be **justified**.
- G) Add the official flag of the country represented in color
- H) The position document consists mainly of 4 sections:

1. **Heading**

Committee Name

Official Country Name

School of origin

Delegate Name

Topic that is being discussed

2. **First paragraph (Background):** Country Background, general data (government, population, currency, GDP, etc.) Brief introduction to the conflict.

3. Second paragraph (Position taken by the delegation):

- What has your country done about it?
- Have you been involved in any way?
- Is the delegation willing to participate in any way in the conflict? How?
- Do you approve or disapprove the action taken (if any) of the UN or other nations?

4. **Third paragraph (Justification)**

- Why does your country have that point of view?
- What suggestions can the delegation suggest to resolve the conflict?

Topic A: Implement Security Measures to eradicate terrorist attacks by rebel groups in Middle East.
